## **Create Transparencies with Video**

## What you will need


- 1. Hardware
  - a. Web Camera
  - b. Microphone for Personal Computer
- 2. Software
  - a. Windows Movie Maker
  - b. Microsoft Power Point

## Creation of Video


- ➤ Install the Web Camera and the software that comes along.
- ➤ Connect the microphone to the Mic port of your sound card.
- Run Windows Movie Maker from Start > All Programs > Accessories Windows Movie Maker.




> The first picture of the program will look like this




> Start recording by pressing the Record button




> At the window that pops up make the following configuration




➤ At the option Record choose Video and audio




➤ At the option Setting choose Other...




Then at the pull down menu choose Video for single channel ISDN (64Kbps)




➤ Now you are ready to start the recording of the video for the first transparency. Start by pressing the Record button.



➤ When you want to stop the recording press the Stop button.




- ➤ It is recommended to save the output video in a subfolder e.g. (C:\Conference\Presentation\Transparency001.wmv) etc.
- ➤ When you have created the videos for all transparencies open the Power Point Template we suggest to you (SuperNova).




➤ In the first transparency write the title of the paper and the name of the author.




➤ In the second transparency you can write the topic of the section and the main points of the presentation.




➤ At the left of the transparency there is space left for the participant to embed the video.



➤ Inside Power Point choose menu Insert > Video and sound > Video from file...



➤ Choose the video that corresponds to the specific transparency.



➤ At the question "Do you want your movie to play automatically in the slide show? If not it will play when you click it" answer **Yes**.




> Drag and drop the video to the correct location.

**Initial** Final





➤ Present new chapters of your presentation through the next transparency.



➤ Alternatively instead of inserting a video you can insert sound only. Use Sound Recorder to capture the sound and insert it following the previous process.



Save the transparency and send it along with the paper.
